National Squad Training & Selection Programmes

The national squad training and selection programmes will start in January 2012. Initially these will include Karate, Freestyle, Muay Thai, Tae Kwon Do, Forms and Weapons, and will consist of weekly sessions at local venues plus a monthly advanced session at a Centre of Excellence with national coaches. These programmes will also be available throughout Europe at selected venues and will follow the same format in each country. The monthly advanced sessions will be filmed and broadcast in two hundred countries to an audience of some 30,000,000 viewers on various television networks.

The cost of these programmes will be spread over twelve affordable monthly payments under an annual renewable contract, without exception. The monthly fee will include free registration with the World Martial Arts Council, free squad uniform and tracksuit, all travel and accommodation expenses to tournaments anywhere in the world, all competition entry fees, three local training sessions each month, and one monthly advanced class with the national coaches at a designated Centre of Excellence in each country.

We are presently seeking paid senior coaches in all martial arts to co-ordinate these programmes in their own localities and countries under the supervision of the WMAC Technical Board, and who will be required to adhere to strict rules and a code of martial arts practice. All those wishing to become paid squad coaches, and those interested in participating in the training and selection programmes, should e-mail their full contact details listing all qualifications, experience, and achievements to the **orientalsportsassociation@hotmail.com** without delay. All places are limited and will only be allocated to those able to give, and demonstrate, total commitment to the programmes. These positions are open to all martial artists regardless of any present affiliations.

Please note: Under no circumstances will any paid coach or squad member be required to leave their present associations in order to become active participants in these programmes. Any present grades, titles, and positions held in any other martial arts organizations will be fully recognized and respected, but it must be fully understood participants in any subsequent tournaments endorsed by the World Martial Arts Council shall represent WorldMAC and not any other organization to which they are affiliated.

STOP PRESS

The World Martial Arts Council is to introduce a television programme dedicated to all martial arts disciplines, their associated cultures, and all participating organizations across the globe. This will be for the duration of one hour every week, and will be broadcast in 200 countries to a potential 30,000,000 viewers. The Council is currently seeking suitable footage, videos, photographs, and any other material for inclusion in these innovative productions, that will include regular interviews with leading martial artists and instructors, serialized teaching courses, seminars, competition promotions, educational courses, cultural

World Directory of Officials

We are in the process of compiling an official international directory of qualified martial arts judges, referees and officials, and invites all such persons to apply for inclusion which is free of charge. In order to be included it is necessary to provide us with all relevant details and copies of any certificates obtained pertaining to courses attended and present level of qualification, irrespective of the awarding body. The compilation of this directory will eliminate poor standards of refereeing, and provide tournament organisers with access to fully qualified, unbiased and competent officials, without the need to rely on volunteers from within their own associations. All those included will receive official notification of entry, and will be responsible for the provision of all details regarding updated personal information.

A & E Assessment

If someone walks in to A & E, they will be assessed based on the depth of the wound, its angle and where it is on their body as well as the amount of blood a person is losing. When a stabbing victim is being brought in by ambulance, the emergency team is ready in the resuscitation room to receive them. People who carry knives do recognise the damage that can be done and usually have a 'bravado' in their attitude. If you believe carrying a knife is for your own self-defence then the reality is that pulling a knife is likely to result in someone being seriously injured
